Structure Guidelines

Please remember to note the following conditions:

Sheds, greenhouses and poly-tunnels are permitted with prior written approval from the Parish Council on condition that:-

- Maximum shed size 8ft by 6ft
- Maximum greenhouse size 8ft by 6ft
- Maximum poly tunnel footprint 80 square foot.
- No more than 20% of a plot being used for structures. The structure must be sound and safe but must not be of a permanent nature.
- The structure should create minimal impact on neighbouring plots.
- Any shed or greenhouse must be fitted with a rainwater collection system feeding a water butt on the plot.
- Glass panes are not permitted
- Sheds must be of natural colour with black or green felt roof.
- Buildings and structures must not be installed on a permanent base such as concrete. It may be placed on paving slabs, girders or similar items that are easy to remove.
- Allotment holders will be asked to make good or remove any non-compliant structures.
