

Roadworks are starting in your area soon

What's happening, where and when?

What: Temporary Traffic Management- Essential maintenance repairs to improve the condition and structural stability of the retaining wall on Spencer Parade.

Where: Spencer Parade, Stanwick

Date: Monday 7th August 2023 – Friday 18th August 2023 (weekdays only)

Times: 08:00 – 16:00 (Road open as usual outside of these hours)

Traffic Management: Works will be carried out using 2-way temporary traffic signals, this is to ensure the safety of our teams and members of the public using the footways and carriageways. The road will be open as usual outside of the working hours stated above

Residents/Businesses: Access will not be restricted to any properties or businesses, but there may be slight delays when passing the works area. We ask for your patience while we carry out these essential works.

Parking: We ask that all vehicles are parked away from the area highlighted **RED** below during working hours to allow sufficient space for the traffic management to be installed, which will aid with the flow of traffic through the village. If for any reason you may have issues moving your vehicle, please let us know prior to the commencement date.

Public Transport: Public transport will not be affected, but please allow for extra time.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: A footway closure will also be in place during working hours. All pedestrians will need to use the footway on the other side of the carriageway.

Emergency Vehicles: Emergency vehicles will not be affected, but delays are possible.



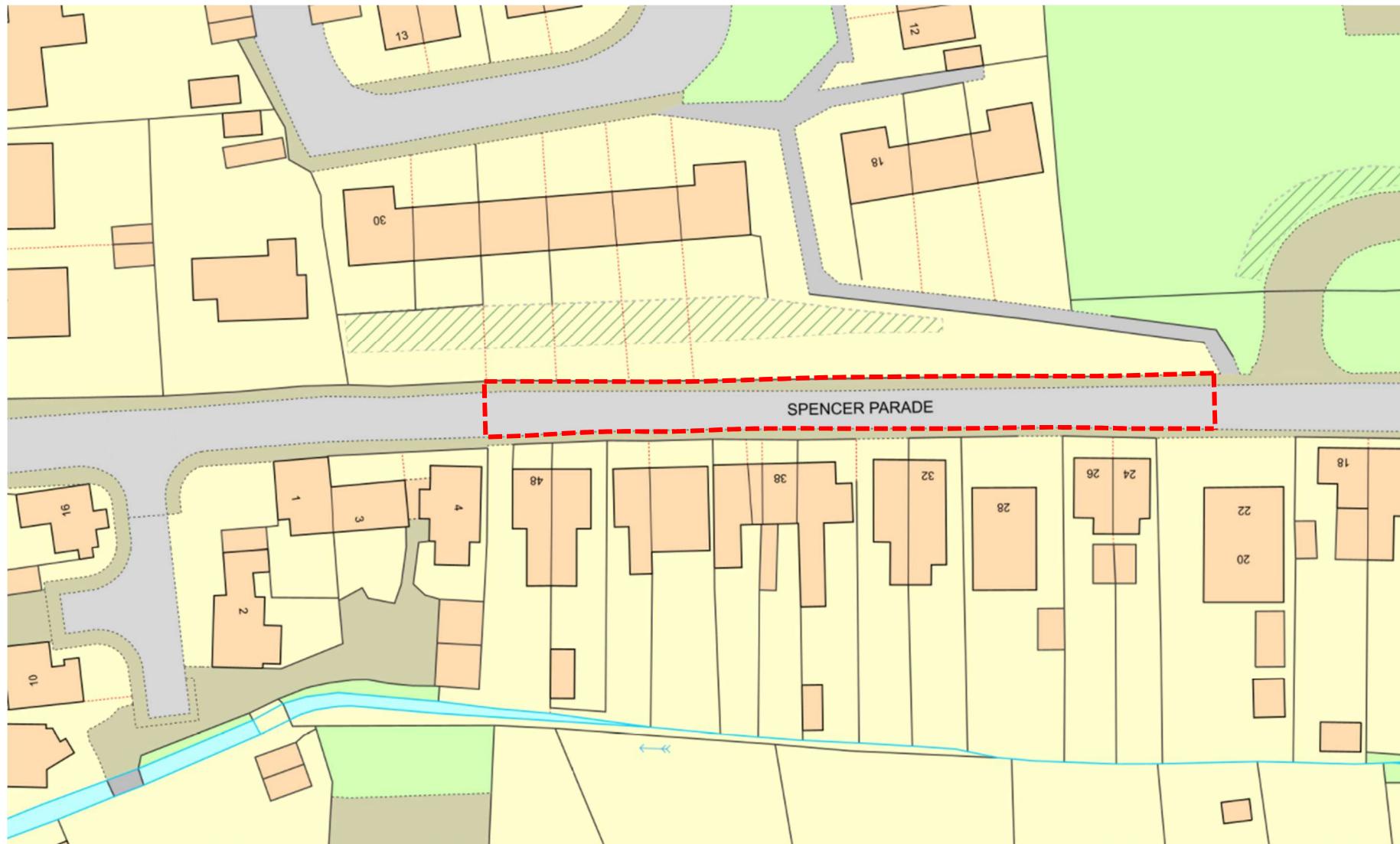
