

Before recycling we should aim to **REDUCE** the amount we use

And then **RE USE** it before

RECYCLING wherever possible

The list below is not exhaustive and will be added to as and when new options become known.

We will do our best to ensure the list is current and up to date but we are not responsible for the actions of any third party who may withdraw the recycling/collection option at any time.

Plant pots and compost bags etc – Cherry Lane Garden Centre (formally Poddingtons) takes used pots & sacks but also allows you to take away any pots you want free of charge.

Wire coat hangers – offer to dry cleaners

Plastic trouser hangers with clips – offer to local ironing services in Stanwick

Water filter cartridges – Tesco has collection bins

Light bulbs - Tesco has collections bins. B&Q has a collection point for fluorescent tubes

Small electricals – kerb side collection by North Northants Council. (leave in a clear plastic bag by your wheelie bin on the usual collection day)

Bedding – animal charities

Tablet blister packs – Superdrug Wellingborough Swan Gate Centre

Medicines – unused medicines should be returned to a pharmacy for safe disposal

Batteries – most supermarkets have collection points (do not put them in your wheelie bins – they can cause fires)

Clean soft plastics – Aldi (Irthlingborough) have a collection bin for plastic film, pet food pouches, sweet wrappers, biscuit wrappers & bread bags by the exit door

Spectacles – Opticians such as Boots will take your old glasses
