

Memorial Gardens, Spencer Parade

Location

Spencer Parade adjacent to the village hall.

Description

The garden is 678 sq m. The garden is bounded by the village hall on east, residential properties on the south and west.

The brook is culverted under the path to the south of the gardens. There is no access to the brook with from within the gardens.

Facilities

Public garden area with trees, shrubs and grass. Gate at rear to Stanwick Village Hall

There is one public bench and one litter bin.

The garden can only be reached on foot via foot path from Spencer Parade. There is a path on three sides.

Hazard	Who	Level of risk	Mitigation
Trips and falls typically giving rise to minor cuts and abrasions, twisted ankles etc.	Visitors, contractors	Low	Care to be taken by individuals; should be alert to local surface conditions.
Falling trees & branches causing injury	Visitors, contractors	Low	Regular inspections take place. Qualified tree surgeon to inspect trees every 3-5 years or more frequently is required.
Scratches from low hanging branches	Visitors, contractors	Low	Branches to be lifted as required.
Personal injury through ground work being undertaken	Visitors	Low	Parish Council grounds maintenance contractors have risk assessments in place, inspected by ENC risk assessment officer. Public Liability Insurance and/or risk assessments required from any other contractor working at the rec.

Note: Level risk represents both the likelihood of occurrence as well as the severity of injury.

Actions since the last report:

- A tree survey was completed in 2018
- Repairs to the footpath were undertaken in 2018.
